- Hearing magnifiers are available at the sound booth for hearing impaired individuals

Ladies Book Study ~ If you did not sign up for the current Ladies Book Study, please watch for future details of a "Book A Month" discussion group that will begin in the new year.

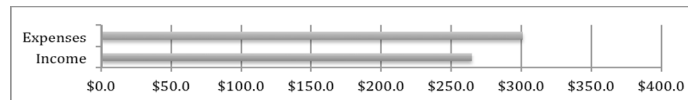
